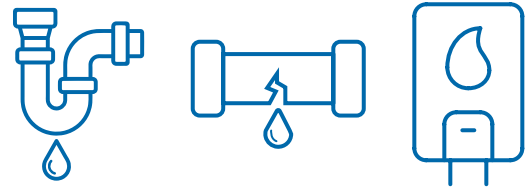




Income eligible homeowners may qualify for water leak repairs, drain line repairs, and gas water heater repairs through the Citizens Energy Group Home Infrastructure Program.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Homeowner must be living in the home.
- The home must be connected to Citizens Energy Group sewer.
- The name on the Citizens Energy Group sewer bill must match the name on the deed to the house. This information can be verified with the Marion County Assessor.
- Household is under 70% State Median Income (see Income Guidelines)
- Homes on septic or well water are not eligible for water/drain repairs.
- Rentals, rent to buy, and land contract homes are not eligible.
- Gas water heater repair - home must be connected to Citizens Energy Group gas service and in the name of the homeowner.



ELIGIBLE REPAIRS

Inside and outside water leaks, inside and outside sewer/drain line backups, and leaking or non-working gas water heaters.
