


How Does This Interact with Citizens' Water Supply?



- The Indianapolis area receives approximately 42 inches of rain annually; however, the water supply has not always been available when needed
- Citizens Reservoir, located on Olio Road next to Geist Reservoir, provides **more than 3 billion gallons of additional water storage** capacity to the Central Indiana water supply
- Excess flow from Geist Reservoir is diverted through an intake structure located between Geist Reservoir and Citizens Reservoir and can allow approximately **100 million gallons per day** of otherwise underutilized water into Citizens Reservoir
- The stored water can be pumped back into Geist Reservoir during dry periods to **flow downstream to the Fall Creek and White River Treatment Plants** for distribution around Central Indiana
- The new Citizens Reservoir creates a more resilient water supply for Central Indiana and all Citizens customers by helping to **ensure sufficient water supplies are available during periods of drought** and to support continued economic development and growth for future generations
